## Do the Math — What is the real cost of smoking?

### Have children do the math:

Today, a pack of cigarettes costs approximately \$6.29 in Oklahoma. If a person smokes one pack per day, how much does he or she spend on cigarettes in one year? Two years?

Make a chart with the cost of cigarettes in a month, a year and two years. Have kids name some things they could buy with that amount of money instead of cigarettes. Ask them if they think it is worth burning their money to smoke.
