CELEBRATING ALLAN HOUSER

AN OKLAHOMA PERSPECTIVE



Numerous Oklahoma museums and cultural institutions have partnered with the Oklahoma Museums Association to present "Celebrating Allan Houser: An Oklahoma Perspective," which recognizes the 100th anniversary of Apache artist Allan Houser's birth. The celebration features exhibitions and events across the state through December 2014 to honor the Oklahoma native.

Participating institutions include the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum, the Oklahoma Arts Council at the Oklahoma State Capitol, the Gilcrease Museum, The Fred Jones Jr. Museum of Art, the Oklahoma History Center, the Oklahoma City Museum of Art, the Chisholm Trail Heritage Center, the OSU Museum of Art at the Postal Plaza Gallery, the Philbrook Downtown, the Southern Plains Indian Museum and the Oklahoma City Airport Trust at Will Rogers World Airport.

Each exhibition focuses on a unique aspect of Houser's life and artistic contributions that span more than 60 years. Visitors can engage in Houser's role as a teacher and mentor, explore his evolution into abstract sculpture, examine the creative process through numerous sketchbooks and honor his significant impact as an award-winning artist. The celebration also includes educational opportunities and activities for children.
